- 2. For the purposes of this testing, a level of 1% (DNA or meat) is being used as a pragmatic level to distinguish between gross contamination or adulteration, and 'trace' levels of carry-over from one species or product to another.
- 3. Businesses are asked to report all results positive for horse immediately to FSA. All the positive results reported in this collated report relate to products for which appropriate action has been taken, including withdrawal and appropriate notification to customers and consumers, and which are being investigated see Table 2 below.
- 4. FSA is also aware of a number of other positive results which have been detected either by industry prior to the formal testing programme or through other testing and investigations by the FSA and by local authorities. These are listed in Table 3
- 5. The businesses and organisations listed in Table 4 below contributed data for this return on industry testing.
