## THE INVESTIGATORY POWERS BILL: ANALYSIS ON THE APPLICATION OF STANDING ORDER NO.83L OF THE STANDING ORDERS OF THE HOUSE OF COMMONS RELATING TO PUBLIC BUSINESS IN RESPECT OF GOVERNMENT AMENDMENTS TABLED FOR REPORT STAGE

 Annex A to the explanatory notes published alongside the Bill set out the Department's assessment of the Bill on its introduction to the House of Commons. The following is the Department's assessment of the Bill as amended in Public Bill Committee and the government amendments tabled to the Bill for consideration at Report Stage.

## The Bill as amended in Public Bill Committee.

- 2. The amendments made to the Bill in Public Bill Committee did not change the Department's assessment of the Bill. The amendments did not introduce any new clauses.
- 3. The Bill extends to the whole of the United Kingdom. This is subject to the exception that amendments, repeals and revocations have the same extent as the enactment to which they relate. There are no clauses or Schedules in the Bill that apply only to England or only to England and Wales, as set out in the table below.
- 4. It is therefore not necessary to consider, for the purposes of Standing Order No. 83J of the Standing Orders of the House of Commons relating to Public Business, whether any provisions have minor or consequential effects outside England and Wales, or whether any provisions would be within the competence of any of the devolved legislatures.<sup>1</sup>
- 5. The above assessment is presented in tabular form below. Differences between this table and that in the explanatory notes published alongside the Bill on its introduction are a result of the analysis of the provisions which require legislative consent having been refined in discussion with the devolved administrations.

## **Commons Report Stage Amendments**

6. The following is the Department's assessment of the amendments to the Bill tabled by the government for consideration at Commons Report Stage.

- 7. None of the amendments to existing clauses of or Schedules to the Bill alter the territorial application of the clause or Schedule in question. Nor do any of the amendments to existing clauses or Schedules change the analysis set out in Table 1 above.
- 8. The government has tabled new clauses for consideration at Commons Report Stage. The new clauses extend to the whole of the United Kingdom. None of the new clauses apply only to England or only to England and Wales.
- 9. It is therefore not necessary to consider, for the purposes of Standing Order No. 83L of the Standing Orders of the House of Commons relating to Public Business, whether any provisions have minor or consequential effects outside England and Wales, or whether any provisions would be within the competence of any of the devolved legislatures.<sup>2</sup>
