### **Memorandum for the Delegated Powers and Regulatory Reform Committee**

The Telecommunications Infrastructure (Leasehold Property) Bill was introduced in the House of Commons on 8 January 2020, and had its Third Reading on 10 March 2020. To assist with the Delegated Powers and Regulatory Reform Committee's scrutiny of the Bill, the Government has prepared a Delegated Powers Memorandum.

This memorandum identifies the provisions of the Bill that confer powers to make delegated legislation. It explains in each case why the power has been taken and explains the nature of, and the reason for, the procedure selected. I will place a copy of this report into the Libraries of both Houses.
