Dear Mr O'Brien,

As National Statistician and Chief Executive of the UK Statistics Authority, I am replying to your Parliamentary Question asking what proportion of (a) White British, (b) Indian, (c) Pakistani, (d) Bangladeshi, (e) Black African and (f) Black Caribbean households were (i) owner occupiers, (ii) social renters and (iii) private renters in each year since 1991 **(70492)**.

Tables containing extracted data from the 2001 and 2011 Censuses for the local authority of Harborough have been placed in the House of Commons library. Equivalent data has been provided for the county of Leicestershire and for England and Wales to enable comparisons to be made. Unfortunately, I am unable to provide counts for this cross-tabulation of variables from the 1991 Census.
