I am writing to follow-up on the question you raised on 15 April, following Lord Campbell's question on the discussions Her Majesty's Government has had with NATO allies regarding the recent amassing of Russian forces on the Ukrainian border.

You raised the fact that the United Kingdom is a signatory of the 1994 Budapest Memorandum and asked whether the Government agrees that this gives us a continuing responsibility for the security and territorial integrity of Ukraine.

In my response, I referred to our commitment to the convention that was signed. I would like to clarify that it is in fact, as you stated, a memorandum.
