FINANCE BILL: CLAUSE 73

Thank you for your question at the Finance Bill Public Bill Committee on 5 January, in relation to Clause 73. You asked for additional detail on the regulations that we envisage making under that clause.

The regulations, laid by DIT Ministers, will set out further detail regarding how transition reviews and reconsiderations of transition reviews called in by the Secretary of State will be conducted. This will include, but is not limited to, the publication of relevant material, how the Trade Remedies Authority will support the Secretary of State in her decision making and providing a right of appeal from called in decisions.
