## Executive Summary

### General

- All data for this publication are taken from the Joint Personnel Administration (JPA) system. Due to ongoing validation of data from this system, all location data are currently provisional, out of scope of National Statistics and subject to review.
- The Tri-Service total strength has increased by 1.7% from 188,370 at 1<sup>st</sup> April 2009 to 191,660 at 1<sup>st</sup> April 2010.
- The Tri-Service total strength stationed in the United Kingdom has increased by 2.1% from 162,710 at 1<sup>st</sup> April 2009 to 166,060 at 1<sup>st</sup> April 2010.
- Due to technical issues concerning the mapping software used by DASA in TSP10, maps showing the distribution of UK Regular Forces by Local Authority are not currently available. TSP-10 will be updated with the maps, once they become available.

### Naval Service

- No major changes this quarter.

### Army

- **East Riding of Yorkshire** has seen a rise in personnel from 320 in Jan 10 to 520 in Apr 10. This is due to Soldier intake at Defence School of Transport (DST – Normandy Barracks).
- **Richmondshire** has seen a fall in personnel from 8,000 in Jan 10 to 7,940 in Apr 10. This is due to the cyclical nature of training units at Infantry Training Centre – Catterick barracks.
- **South Cambridgeshire** has seen a fall in personnel from 1,920 in Jan 10 to 1,770 in Apr 10. This is due to the cyclical nature of training units at Bassingbourn barracks.
- **Bracknell Forest** has seen a rise in personnel from 1,000 in Jan 10 to 1,080 in Apr 10. This is due to the cyclical nature of training units at the Royal Military Academy, Sandhurst.
- **Winchester** has seen a fall in personnel from 960 in Jan 10 to 820 in Apr 10 due to the cyclical nature of training units at Army Training Regiment Winchester.
- **Guildford** has seen a fall in personnel from 2,600 in Jan 10 to 2,480 in Apr 10. This is due to the cyclical nature of training units at Army Training Regiment Pirbright.

### Royal Air Force

- **Aylesbury Vale** saw a reduction in personnel due to the cyclical nature of training units at RAF Halton.

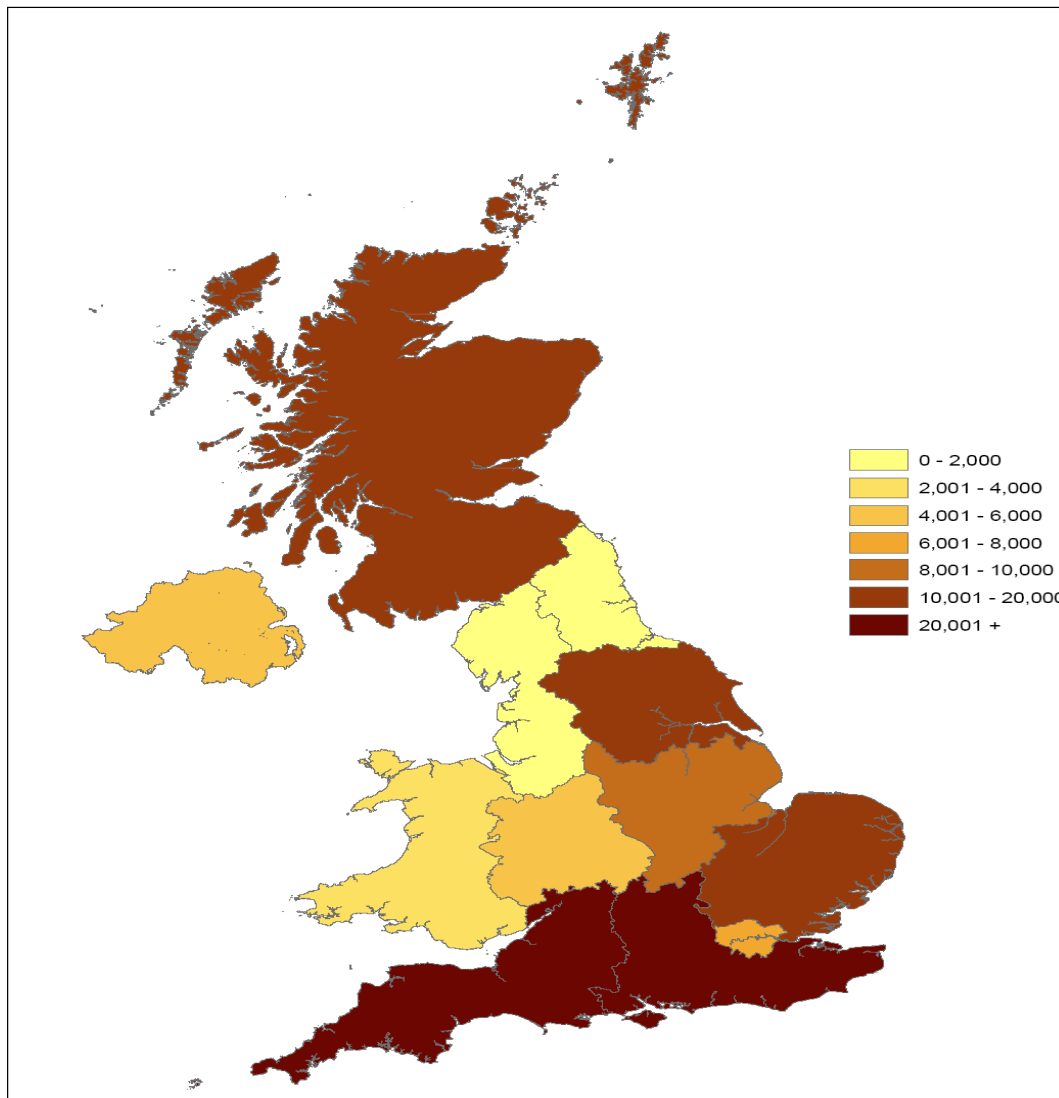
