DFID Projects in the Kyrgyz Republic

DFID has been active in Kyrgyz Republic since 1997. We use a range of aid instruments including, technical assistance projects, programme-based support, and sector budget support to the health sector, which is unique in the region. Current projects are:

1. Support to Strengthening Public Finance Management

Timing: 2009 – 2013

Total Cost: £5m - disbursed through Multi Donor Trust Fund with World Bank (WB), Swiss

Development Cooperation (SDC) and Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA)

and the European Union (EU)

Implementer: Ministry of Finance (MoF)

Recipient: Government of Kyrgyz Republic – Ministry of Finance **Donor Partners:** Joint Financiers are WB, SDC, SIDA & EU

Purpose: The programme works to strengthen effectiveness, efficiency, and accountability of Public

Finance Management.

2. **Health SWAp** (Sector wide approach, on-budget co-financing)

Total Cost: £10m disbursed through Multi Donor Trust Fund with WB, Swiss Development Cooperation (SDC) and Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA)

Implementer: Government of Kyrgyz Rep Ministry of Finance (MoF) & Ministry of Health (MoH)

3. Rural Water Supply and Sanitation Project, Phase 2

Recipient: Community Drinking Water Users Unions

Purpose: To improve hygiene, sanitation, and water supply facilities at village and family levels in 3 oblasts (provinces) Issyk-Kul, Talas and Naryn. ADB target the remaining 4 oblasts Chui, Batken, Jal-

Alabad and Osh

4. Village Investment Programme, Phase 2

Timing: 2007-2011

Total Cost: £8.6M - disbursed through Single Donor Trust Fund with WB **Implementer:** ARIS (Community Development and Investment Agency) **Recipient:** Communities, Local Self-Governments, Local Administrations

Donor Partners: WB, KfW

Purpose: The project aims at empowering communities to improve access to social and economic

infrastructure services.

5. Democracy and Stability Programme

7. **Regional – Central Asia Migration Programme** (Kyrgyz Republic, Tajikistan, Kazakhstan & the

Russian Federation) **Timing**: 2010-2013 **Total Cost**: £5.9 M

Implementer: International Organisation for Migration (IOM), UNIFEM and the World Bank **Recipient**: male and female labour migrants and their families, communities, and national governments of four countries (Kyrgyz Republic, Tajikistan, Kazakhstan, and the Russian Federation) **Purpose**: The project aims to protect the rights and enhance the social and economic opportunities of migrant men, women, and their families.

8. Regional - Central Asia Programmatic Poverty Assessment (Kyrgyz Republic & Tajikistan)

Timing: 2010 – 2012

Total Cost: £950,000 - disbursed through a Single Donor Trust Fund with WB

Implementer: Governments of Kyrgyz Republic and Tajikistan National Statistics Committees **Recipient:** Governments of Kyrgyz Republic and Tajikistan – National Statistics Committees

Donor Partners: WB

Purpose: The project aims to strengthen national poverty assessment systems in Tajikistan and

Kyrgyz Republic to track and analyse poverty and human development outcomes.

9. Regional - Central Asia Energy and Water Development Programme, Design phase

(Kyrgyz Republic, Tajikistan, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan & Turkmenistan)

Timing: 2010 – 2012

Total Cost: £940,000 - disbursed through a Multi-Donor Trust Fund with WB

Implementer: WB

Recipient: Central Asian Governments **Donor Partners:** World Bank, SDC

Purpose: The project is assisting with the development of a regional programme that will help Central Asian states to improve collaboration and effectiveness in using transboundary water resources. DFID, at this early stage, will support the World Bank to carry out the initial analysis, dialogue, and consultation required to develop the programme.
