

Revocation of retained direct EU legislation

2. The following retained direct EU legislation is revoked—
- (a) Regulation (EC) No 883/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the co-ordination of social security systems;
 - (b) Regulation (EC) No 987/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the procedure for implementing Regulation (EC) No 883/2004;
 - (c) Regulation (EEC) No 1408/71 on the application of social security schemes to employed persons, to self-employed persons and to members of their families moving within the Community;
 - (d) Regulation (EEC) No 574/72 fixing the procedure for implementing Regulation (EEC) No 1408;
 - (e) Regulation (EC) No 859/2003 extending Regulation (EEC) No 1408/71 to nationals of non-EU Member Countries.

Revocation of instruments

3. The following instruments are revoked—
- (a) the Social Security Coordination (Council Regulation (EEC) No 574/72) (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019(a);
 - (b) the Social Security Coordination (Regulation (EC) No 883/2004, EEA Agreement and Swiss Agreement) (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019(b);
 - (c) the Social Security Coordination (Regulation (EC) No 987/2009) (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019(c);
 - (d) the Social Security Coordination (Council Regulation (EEC) No 1408/71 and Council Regulation (EC) No 859/2003 (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019(d).

Exclusions

4. Regulation 2 does not revoke any retained direct EU legislation so far as it relates to the coordination of the provision of benefits in kind.

Amendment of the Social Security Co-ordination (Reciprocal Healthcare) (Amendment etc.) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019

5.—(1) The Social Security Co-ordination (Reciprocal Healthcare) (Amendment etc.) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019(e) are amended as follows.

- (2) Omit regulation 10.
- (3) In regulation 16(c), omit the words from “, so far as not omitted” to the end.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

Regulation 2 of these Regulations revokes Regulation (EC) No 883/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the co-ordination of social security systems, Regulation (EC) No 987/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the procedure for implementing Regulation (EC) No 883/2004, Regulation (EEC) No 1408/71 on the application of social security schemes to employed persons, to self-employed persons and to members of their families moving within the Community and Regulation (EEC) No 574/72 fixing the procedure for implementing Regulation (EEC) No 1408 and Regulation (EC) No 859/2003 extending Regulation (EEC) No 1408/71 to nationals of non-EU Member Countries. Those Regulations relate to the co-ordination of social security systems throughout the EU.

Regulation 3 of these Regulations revokes the Social Security Coordination (Council Regulation (EEC) No 574/72) (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (S.I. 2019/721), the Social Security Coordination (Regulation (EC) No 883/2004, EEA Agreement and Swiss Agreement) (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (S.I. 2019/722), the Social Security Coordination (Regulation (EC) No 987/2009) (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (S.I. 2019/723) and the Social Security Coordination (Council Regulation (EEC) No 1408/71 and Council Regulation (EC) No 859/2003 (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (S.I. 2019/726). Those Regulations were made under the powers in section 8(1) of the 2018 Act amending the retained direct EU legislation revoked by regulation 2.

Regulation 4 excludes matters relating to the coordination of the provision of benefits in kind from the scope of the revocations in regulation 2.

Regulation 5 of these Regulations makes amendments to the Social Security Co-ordination (Reciprocal Healthcare) (Amendment etc.) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (S.I. 2019/776) which are consequential on the revocations made by regulations 2 and 3.
