Embargoed Public Bundle - India Free Trade Agreement Negotiations

Ahead of the official launch of free trade agreement negotiations with the Government of India, please see attached embargoed copies of the public bundle, which comprises of:

- 1. Our outline approach to negotiations, setting out our objectives for the negotiations
- 2. A response to the public consultation on trade with India, setting out how it has informed our policy

- 4. A scoping assessment, providing a preliminary economic assessment of the impact of the agreement
