Signed Determination to extend the temporary Universal Credit surplus earnings de minimis of £2,500 from 1 April 2022.

As part of the Autumn budget statement and spending review 2021 (27 October 2021) we announced that, "The government will continue the temporary increase in the surplus earnings threshold to £2,500 for Universal Credit claimants until April 2023". For this measure to continue to be in force from the 1 April 2021, the Secretary of State for Work and Pensions is required to sign a Determination.

I have signed the Determination on behalf of the Secretary of State for Work and Pensions and a PDF copy of the signed Determination is attached for deposit in the House libraries.
