I would like to make a correction to an answer I gave during the debate on the Procurement Bill on 28 November 2022, which was recorded in Hansard Volume 825.

In responding to a question on the interplay between the Procurement Bill and the Health and Care Act, I unintentionally misspoke when I said "The Bill provides for new and separate rules for healthcare services to patients and service users, although not for goods except those that are an integral part of the delivery of a clinical care services contact." (column 1591).

I should have instead said "That Act provides for new and separate rules for healthcare services to patients and service users, although not for goods except those that are an integral part of the delivery of a clinical care services contract."
