When reviewing this data, it is important to note:

- a. SFA data has been provided by Defence Infrastructure Organisation (DIO) [between March and May 2023].
- b. SLA data has been provided by Single Service Infrastructure teams [between March and May 2023].
- c. **SLA units** do not include short term (transit) accommodation. Transit accommodation is used to meet a variety of short-term demands, including surges of personnel under temporary operational requirement.
- d. Strength data has been provided by Analysis (Tri-Service) [May 2023], correct as at 1 January 2023.
- e. **Strength** refers to all UK Regulars, Gurkhas, and Full Time Reserve Service on Full Commitment (FTRS-FC) personnel, as they are all entitled to Service Living Accommodation (SLA) and Service Family Accommodation (SFA). Other Reservist Personnel and Personnel who are only entitled to surplus SLA and SFA have been excluded. This strength differs from the Annual Location Statistics publication which focuses on UK Regulars only.
- f. FTRS Personnel fill Service posts for a set period on a full-time basis while being a member of one of the Reserve Forces, either as an ex-regular or as a volunteer (this is different from mobilisation). An FTRS-FC fulfils the same range of duties and deployment liability as a Regular Service person.
- g. **Strength** figures are based on Service Personnel's stationed location and not their location of residence: individuals do not necessarily work and live in the same place. Personnel deployed on operations to an area away from their stationed location are shown against their most-recent stationed location.
- h. **Strength** figures are estimates because the stationed location data for Full Time Reserve Service (FTRS) personnel cannot be fully verified. Numbers can also vary according to activity, duty, and exercise requirements.
- i. **Strength** figures in this table have been rounded to the nearest 10, though numbers ending in a "5" have been rounded to the nearest multiple of 20 to prevent the systematic bias caused by always rounding numbers upwards. Figures between 1 and 5 inclusive are represented by "~" to prevent possible disclosure, and zero represented by "-".
- j. We have not released information about **sensitive sites**, as this would reveal operational capability and increase risk to our personnel.
