THE INDEPENDENT REVIEW OF RESEARCH BUREAUCRACY - GOVERNMENT RESPONSE

I am writing about the government's response to the Independent Review of Research Bureaucracy, led by Professor Adam Tickell, which is being published on Friday 9 February.

This response provides a clear roadmap on how we will work with the sector to reshape the research system so that UK researchers can spend more time driving transformative discoveries and less tied down by unnecessary bureaucracy.
