Tackling antisemitism in schools and universities

During the Oral Statement on Antisemitism in the United Kingdom in the House of Commons on Monday 19 February, you requested an update on how the £7 million announced in the Autumn Statement to tackle antisemitism in schools and universities had been allocated. I advised the House that I would come back on this point.

I can confirm that following the commitment set out in the Autumn Statement, the Department for Education has put together a programme to tackle antisemitism in schools, colleges and universities. **£5.5 million** of the **£7 million** total available funding will be allocated to the Tackling Antisemitism in Education programme. The tender for the delivery of this programme went live on **6 February** and will close on **7 March 2024 at 3.00pm**. It consists of two lots: (i) Universities and (ii) Schools and Colleges.
