WESTMINSTER HALL DEBATE

I would like to thank you again for your engagement on the matter of duty solicitors. During the debate, I mentioned that I would share the figures that I referred to. These figures are published on https://www.gov.uk/guidance/duty-solicitors-rotas-information-and-guidance but the table below provides a summary of the data. As of 6 March 2024, the figures for the number of duty solicitors signed up to the Legal Aid Agency (LAA) crime contracts are as follows:

I would like to clarify that while the data does show some increase in the number of duty solicitors registering on the scheme after October 2022, I understand that there may be specific administrative reasons for that increase. Nonetheless, the slowing rate of decline is potentially an early sign of at least some stabilisation in the scheme.

As mentioned during the debate, I meet regularly with the LAA to discuss matters pertaining to criminal legal aid. The LAA regularly reviews and monitors the number of duty solicitors on each local duty scheme to ensure adequate provision and access to legal aid. It has arrangements in place to ensure that all duty schemes have cover 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

We have already boosted the system with immediate investment in response to the criminal legal aid independent review and are investing a further £16m into the police station scheme which will benefit the duty solicitor schemes. This additional funding will contribute to the sustainability of the market and help to ensure that legal aid is accessible in the future.
