**Notes/Caveats:**

1. Figures in Table 1 are for all personnel with an Arm / Service of the Parachute Regiment and Intelligence Corps regardless of whether they are currently serving elsewhere.
2. Figures in Tables 1 and 2 are for all Regular personnel regardless of Training Status.
3. For Tables 1-3, figures are for the Regular Army only and therefore exclude Gurkhas, Full Time Reserve Service, Mobilised Reserves, Army Reserve and all other Reserves, but include those personnel that have transferred from GURTAM to UKTAP.
4. For Tables 1-3, Officers of Paid Rank Colonel and above are included in Staff regardless of late Arm/Service.
5. There is a break in the time series in Table 3 due to a change to the definition of Untrained Intake. Untrained Intake figures prior to and including 2016/17 include all personnel entering both Phase 1 and Phase 2 training. Following a change in definition of trained strength from 1 October 2016, all Untrained Intake figures from 2017/18 onwards only include personnel who entered Phase 1 training. Figures from 2017/18 onwards are therefore not directly comparable with previous Financial Years.
6. Applications figures in Table 3 are for all personnel who applied to join the Parachute Regiment and Intelligence Corps as their first choice.
7. Grey cells in Table 3 denote information not held.
8. Figures for Table 4 are for Trade Trained Regular and Gurkha Army only and therefore exclude Full Time Reserve Service, Mobilised Reserves and all other Reserves. Figures therefore include Gurkhas serving in Ranger Units.
