To ask His Majesty's Government how many children's homes there were in England at the end of (1) 2021, (2) 2022, and (3) 2023; and how many of those in each year were secure homes.

Your recent Parliamentary Question has been passed to me for response as His Majesty's Chief Inspector for Standards in Education, Children's Services and Skills.

Ofsted regularly publishes official statistics on children's social care, which are available online and include data on the number of children's homes in England.¹ I have included the relevant information from this data below.

Ofsted's end of year data refers to 31 March. The table below shows the number of children's homes in England as at 31 March 2021, 2022 and 2023, and the number of those that were secure children's homes in each year. I have also included our latest data as at 31 August 2023, which is published online in Ofsted's Annual Report 2022/23 data.²
