Multiply (England) – numeracy courses

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Introduction

Multiply is an adult numeracy programme aimed at people:

- without a GCSE / Level 2 or equivalent in maths
- who need numeracy support in work or at home
- aged 19+ (but adults in the 16-19 age group can still access free numeracy courses funded through the Adult Education Budget (AEB))

The provision is available in **England** 2022 and runs until March 2025.

What is different about Multiply courses?

Multiply encourages local areas to take innovative approaches to tackle all forms of adult numeracy issues from pre-entry level to level 2 (or equivalent). Some examples of provision are:

- drop in sessions of a few hours
- short intensive courses
- numeracy to support progression to a particular job or career
- full qualifications delivered in new settings (for example, a workplace)

This provision can provide progression to AEB provision but does not duplicate it.

Course details

Details of courses may become available on your District Provision Tool or you can use the Find a course tool to search for relevant courses for claimants. This will include Multiply and AEB funded courses.

A Quiz tool is available to find out what the claimant's numeracy skill level is. Used alongside the Find a course tool, this will help with identification of suitable courses for the claimant.
