Prosecutions of cyclists

During our exchange at the debate on public bus collisions on 13 May, I committed to writing in response to your question regarding the number of cyclists who have been prosecuted.

The figures provided by the Ministry of Justice in the Outcomes by Offence data tool (which you can access at <u>https://www.gov.uk/government/statistics/criminal-justice-system-statistics-quarterly-june-2023</u>) are the following:
