Dear Lord Polak,

I committed to writing to you following Oral Questions on 6 March on the topic of free entry to the national Holocaust Memorial.

The Department for Culture, Media and Sport has reached out to the Ministry of Housing, Communities & Local Government who are leading on the Memorial scheme. They have confirmed that the Holocaust Memorial and Learning Centre will be free of charge to enter. The cost of running the Memorial and Learning Centre will be met through a mixture of fundraising and grant-in-aid funding, as with many other Government-sponsored organisations.
