
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
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Estimates of voluntary moves to UC

- The table below sets out estimates of natural and voluntary migrations.
- Overall, estimated voluntary migrations have been relatively stable as a % of total migrations, with a slight increase from August-22.
- However, a precise measurement of the number of claimants moving to UC as a direct result of exposure to the communications campaign (e.g. attributable) cannot be made.
 We have no absolute method of measuring claimant motivation to claim.
- Note total migrations here do not include managed migrations.
