Paper Title: Move to UC progress

Introduction

- As we start 2023, we are looking to transition the Move to UC project away from pure discovery and into implementation. The Programme Board agenda includes for example considerations for the operating model and roll out of Tax Credits migration as we look to scale from April.
- From the Discovery cohorts, we continue to use ACSL team and visiting officers to a small number of claimants who have not completed the Move to UC process. Some of these challenging cases will be escalated to the Implementation Control Centre to establish some principles about next steps.

Progress since the last board

- 3. We published on gov.uk the first set of insight from Discovery including detail of the outcomes from the 499 claimants that were part of the Earliest Testable Service. This was followed by a successful event with stakeholders sharing some more detail on the learning and insight.
- 4. Continuous flow of notifying claimants began at low volume in November 2022 (c. 25 claimants a week) and volumes are being increased toward the agreed profile (c. 1,000 / month Jan-Mar 2023).
- 5. HMRC have delivered their IT integration milestones in support of automating TP calculations for Tax Credit customers.
- 6. The Migration Notice has been updated in line with the insights we've gathered from Discovery and is now specific to Tax Credit claimants.

7. The Implementation Control Centre is established and meeting weekly to monitor scaling progress and implementation issues.

Next steps

- 8. As stated previously, learning continues and we do not consider there to be a hard line between the Discovery and Scaling phases of the plan. We continue to close out the various Discovery cohorts and will be able to publish similar data to the ETS data once these are near complete.
- 9. We will continue to innovate and test improvements to the baseline Move to UC journey for Tax Credit claimants. This will form a continuous discovery process running in parallel to the scaling work in the early part of 2023.
- 10. In line with the IPA recommendation, we are doing planning work for running further Discovery of other benefit combinations.

Decision / Recommendation

11. Programme Board are asked to note the progress of the Discovery work and progress towards scaling Tax Credit moves in 2023.
