Dear Diana,

I'd like to thank you for the interesting debate on Clause 50 of the Children's Wellbeing and Schools Bill, which seeks to change the current duty to issue academy orders to the most underperforming maintained schools into a discretionary power.

During the debate I mentioned the fact that around 40% of maintained schools identified for conversion take over a year to become academies. You asked me to clarify whether this figure related to conversions generally or only to conversions into sponsored academies, and I promised to write. I can confirm that the figure relates specifically to the proportion of maintained schools judged by Ofsted to be in a category of concern (i.e. special measures or requires significant improvement) which took more than a year to convert into sponsored academies between 1 January 2022 and 31 December 2024.

Thank you again for taking the time to engage on this matter. I hope this clarification is helpful and I will place a copy of this letter in the House libraries.
